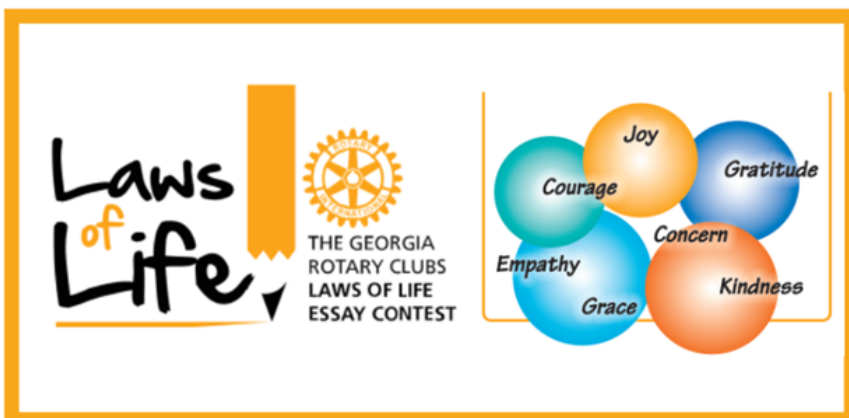
Roswell Rotary Gives

Just the number that the message will come from. So if you see the number **833-456-2829** in your text messages, that's the RRC notification.
