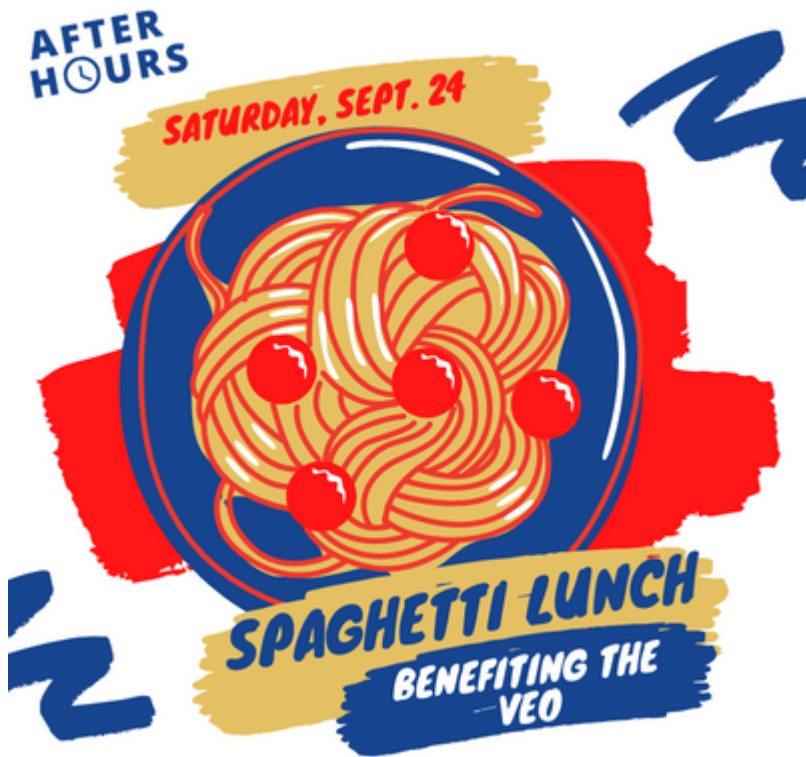
Volunteers Needed for this Saturday Sept. 24 Beaucoup Jazz & Blues Festival

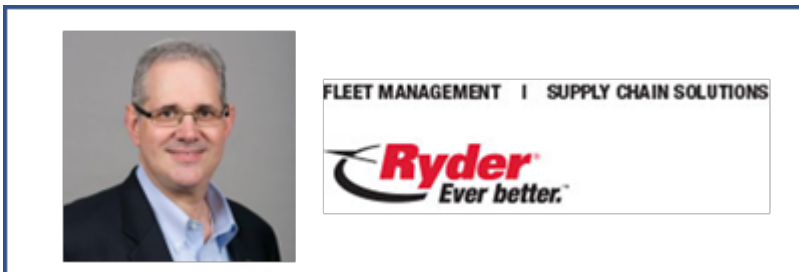
