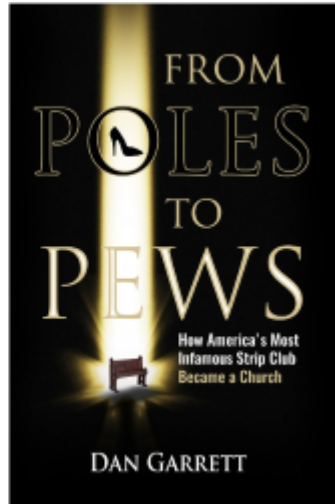


## President Nancy's Message
